

SERVE OPPORTUNITIES

Below is a list of our most needed roles where you can serve and get connected.

FALL ADULT GROUP LEADERS: Guide a short term group designed to help adults grow in faith and build community. Leaders facilitate discussion and help participants stay engaged throughout the semester. No experience required!

Commitment: *Lead a group during the fall semester.*

FRONT DESK SUBS: Step in to support the church office during the week by answering phones, greeting walk in guests, and assisting with basic administrative needs.

Commitment: *As needed during weekday office hours.*

INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLE: We are inviting musicians who play wind, brass, strings, or percussion to be part of this new group. If you play an instrument and would like to use that gift in worship, we would love to connect with you.

Commitment: *Weekly practice.*

PARKING LOT TEAM: Help guests from the moment they arrive on campus. Team members guide traffic, assist first time guests, and direct people to the appropriate entrances.

Commitment: *Serve at 9:30 or 11:00 once or twice per month.*

SUNDAY MORNING KIDS: Provide care for infants–Pre-K during worship. We also have opportunities to support small groups for Grades K–1 and 2–3.

Commitment: *One or two Sundays a month.*

TECH TEAM: Manage sound, lighting, slides, and live stream elements during worship services. This team plays an essential role in supporting each service. No prior experience is required, training is provided.

Commitment: *One or two Sundays a month.*

WELCOME DESK: Serve as a central connection point on Sunday mornings. Answer questions, provide next steps information, and assist with event sign ups. This role helps guests and members know where to go and what to do next.

Commitment: *One or two Sundays a month.*
